Transmission and Distribution: AREVA acquires Nokian Capacitors Ltd. and strengthens its leading position on the transmission market

AREVA's Transmission and Distribution (T&D) Division has signed an agreement with the Finnish company, Nokian Capacitors Ltd, to acquire its activities. The acquisition is of strategic importance for AREVA as it will reinforce its position on the growing high-and ultra high-voltage market.

Nokian Capacitors Ltd. benefits from 50 years of expertise in engineering and manufacturing power system components such as Capacitors in particular. With 2006 sales of 51 million euros, the company currently counts over 290 employees and is represented in 70 countries.

Capacitors are components used in High Voltage Direct Current (HVDC) schemes and Flexible Alternative Current Transmission Systems (FACTS). HVDC and FACTS both help reduce CO₂ emissions by respectively minimizing power losses and ensuring the balance and efficiency of high-voltage transmission networks. They also facilitate the connection of renewable energy sources into the power network.

Nokian Capacitors Ltd's products will complement AREVA's offering and enable its T&D Division to broaden its customer portfolio.

The acquisition is subject to the consultation of trade unions, in compliance with the applicable provisions of the law.

Philippe Guillemot, Chairman and CEO of AREVA T&D, said: "This acquisition will enable AREVA to position itself as a key player on the booming ultra-high voltage T&D markets and to provide its customers with state-of-the-art solutions to minimize their environmental footprint."
